## 1 Polar Loop

Sturdy yet lightweight, one of the most unique factors to Polar's Loop tracker is that it not only counts your daily steps, it also provides you with heart-rate based calorie information thanks to its heart-rate strap. We also love the fact that it's fully waterproof, making it one of the most water-sport friendly trackers out there, and ideal for surfers, swimmers, water polo players and triathletes. The fit can be customised to size, and the interface even tells you the time.

## 2 FitBit Flex

## 3 Garmin Vivofit

If you're the sort of person who forgets to charge your electronic devices often, this is the band for you: the batteries last an entire year. Its always-on digital display screen makes it easy to track your progress at any given time, although it's not backlit so you won't have to worry about evening glow-worm lights. It's also 50m water resistant, making it a truly 24/7/365 wearable device. ## 4 Jawbone UP24

Sleek, stylish and available in three sizes, Jawbone's new rendition of its popular UP band is now wireless and connects via Bluetooth.
