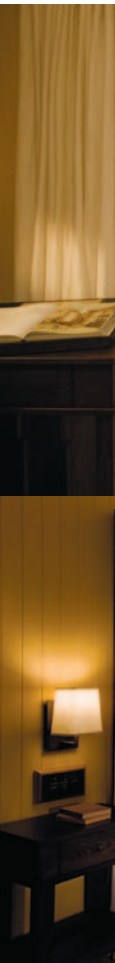
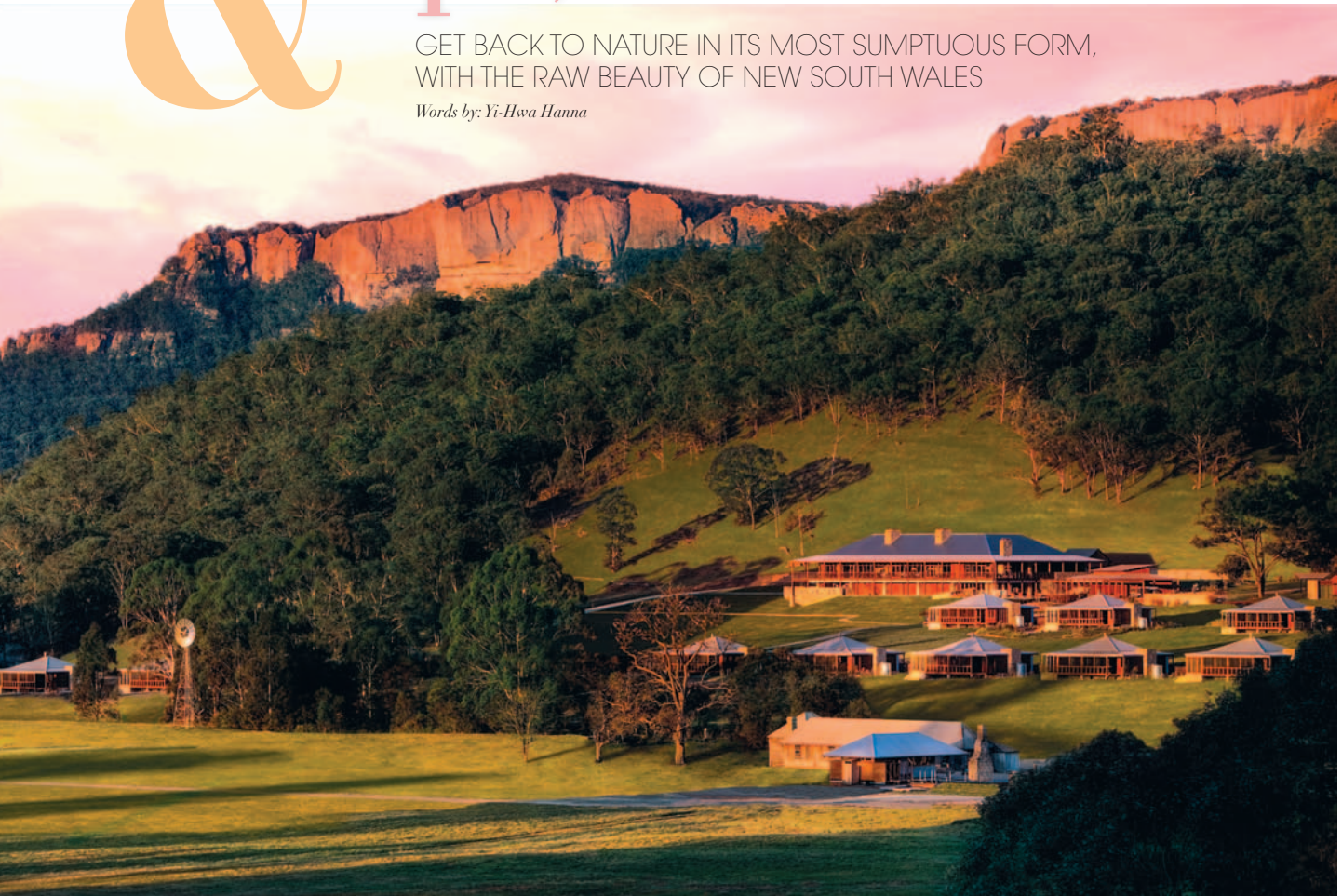


Wolgan Valley Resort & Spa, Australia

FAST FACTS

The rugged, wildlife-rich Wolgan Valley was formed by the Wolgan River in New South Wales, west of Sydney.

Still largely undeveloped, the valley was inhabited by indigenous Australians for thousands of years. The valley's name originates from the word "wolga," an Australian Aboriginal name for a coastal climbing plant.

The Greater Blue Mountains area is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and is known for its lush vegetation including eucalyptus trees (that give the mountains the "blue" part of their name through the oil they secrete) and the rare Wollemi pine.

natural beauty that envelops the resort; simply gazing out at the picturesque landscape from the comforts of your suite will instill a sense of tranquillity. More adventurous folk, meanwhile, can explore their surroundings in greater depth and detail. A vast environment beckons to guests for an array of hiking or safari-style activities.

Wolgan Valley Resort & Spa's environmental consciousness doesn't end with ensuring that it blends seamlessly into its surroundings, it's also committed to offering eco-luxury of the highest pedigree and is the first resort in the world to have achieved internationally accredited carbon neutral certification. Aside from capacious bio-conservation efforts, the resort supplies 35% of its power through renewable energy, and has incorporated heat recovery and solar power usage into its construction. Rainwater is collected and domestic water is recycled, while food and supplies are sourced from within a 100 mile radius.
